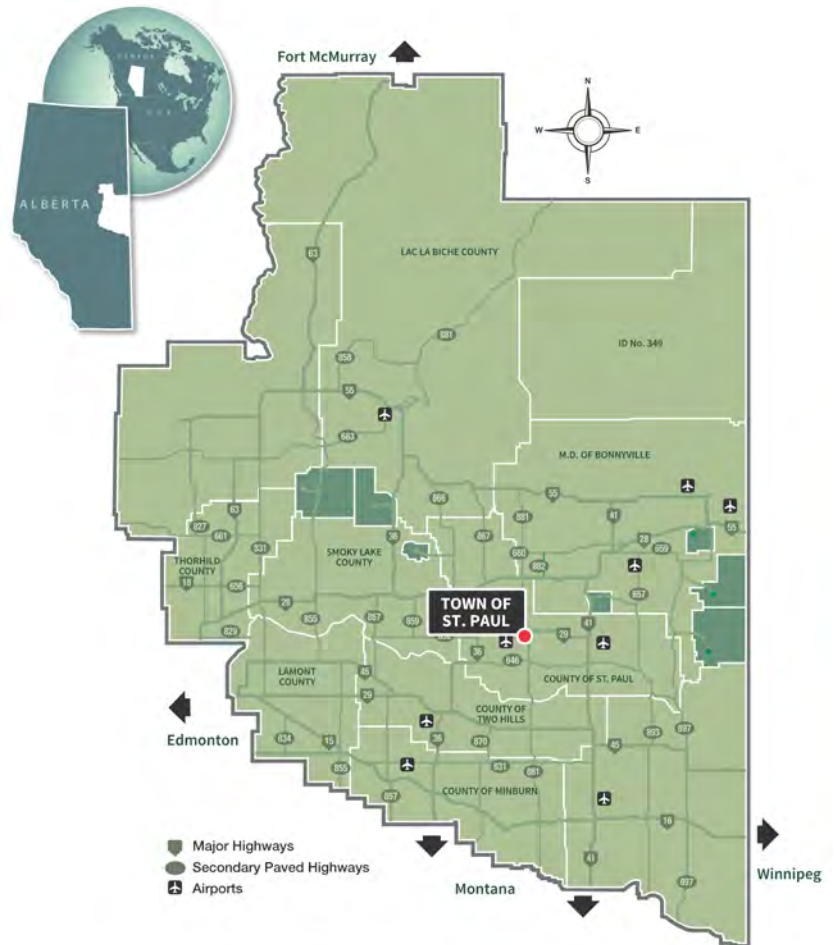


ABOUT THE TOWN OF ST. PAUL

The Town of St. Paul is centrally located in the heart of Northeastern Alberta. St. Paul has a diverse economic base including a rich agricultural sector within the County, supplemented by gas and oil, and served by a strong retail and service sector.

The Town is located on highway 29, which connects to highway 36 to the west and highway 41 to the east, providing access to markets and the Alberta Oil Sands. Surrounded by many lakes and trails, the Town of St. Paul is a hub for recreation and a wealth of opportunity for tourism investment.

The community offers all the amenities for excellent living including the connectivity, social connection, health and education. With something for everyone, St. Paul is a welcoming and friendly "People Kind of Place."



The Town of St. Paul is a member of the Northeast Alberta Information HUB, which is the regional economic development alliance of Northeast Alberta.



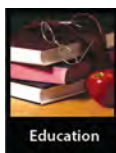
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Healthcare

The St. Paul – St. Therese Healthcare Centre is a combined acute and continuing care facility with services which include special care unit, labour and delivery, palliative care, emergency, rehabilitation, renal dialysis, laboratory and x-ray. As a regional mental health intake, the larger community provides numerous support services.

Residents also enjoy a wide array of health services within the community, including Lakeland Primary Care Network, dental and medical clinics, chiropractors, physiotherapists and alternative health services.

Community Services

A full array of emergency services is provided through 911, including fire, ambulance, and police services. In addition, the Town boasts a wide variety of organizations, services and businesses that support, strengthen and bring the community together ranging from municipal services to stand alone activities. The Town's welcoming Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) is sure to be a first stop for anyone looking to connect to community and the supports available.



Recreation

A variety of recreation facilities are offered in St. Paul including two indoor ice arenas, an indoor swimming pool, a recreation centre/six sheet curling rink, soccer fields, splash park, fishing pond, tennis and pickle ball courts, sports fields, ball diamonds, a bowling alley, movie theatre, 18-hole golf course, the Iron Horse Trail. There many park and camping facilities including two municipal campgrounds within the town limits. St. Paul also boasts the world's first UFO landing pad.
